We need pictures for our 2018 NISA Samoyed Calendar

Do you have a photogenic Rescue Samoyed and what Samoyed isn't photogenic? What about one who gets into mischief? Perhaps you have one who is involved in doggie sports or activities with the family. We are looking for photographs of Samoyeds. They can be action shots or sitting pretty shots. Keep in mind, we need pictures of Samoyeds in the various seasons and holiday pictures as well. So send us your photos that capture the specialness of your Samoyed.

We need many photos of Samoyeds to fill our pages. That means there is plenty of opportunity for your Samoyed no matter how long ago you adopted your Samoyed to grace the calendar pages. If your Sammie has a housemate(s), they can be in the picture as well. Closer in photos are usually better as they capture the expressiveness of your dog. We normally prefer them without humans but sometimes use photos with people.

Your photos need to not have the date on it unless it can be cropped out without losing the essence of the picture. Landscape (horizontal) pictures will work the best for the calendar. Also, for digital photos please save as a jpg file. Resolution needs to be at least 200 pixels per inch. Most cameras default to 72 pi but can be changed to 200. For prints, we can use them however your print will not be returned to you.

Besides the photos, make sure you include information about each photo and, if sending more than one, make clear what description goes with what photo. Please keep your responses short.

Your name, email address (if you have one) and phone number
Who is in the picture? (Go from left to right or right to left, but tell us which. And be sure to name any other pets as well as humans.)
Where is the photo taken (if that is important)?
What is the story of the photograph?
Name of your Samoyed Rescue(s)?
When did you get your dog(s)?
What has life been like with your dog(s)?
